God's glory is the result of his nature and acts. He is glorious in his character, for there is such a store of everything that is holy, and good, and lovely in God, that he must be glorious. The actions which flow from his character are also glorious; but while he intends that they should manifest to his creatures his goodness, and mercy, and justice, he is equally concerned that the glory associated with them should be

given only to himself. Nor is there aught in ourselves in which we may glory; for who maketh us to differ from another? And what have we that we did not receive from the God of all grace? Then how careful ought we to be to walk humbly before the Lord! The moment we glorify ourselves, since there is room for one glory only in the universe, we set ourselves up as rivals to the Most High. Shall the insect of an hour glorify itself against the sun which warmed it into life? Shall the potsherd exalt itself above the man who fashioned it upon the wheel? Shall the dust of the desert strive with the whirlwind? Or the drops of the ocean struggle with

the tempest? Give unto the Lord, all ye righteous, give unto the Lord glory and strength; give unto him the honour that is due unto his name. Yet it is, perhaps, one of the hardest struggles of the Christian life to learn this sentence--"Not unto us, not unto us, but unto thy name be glory." From the Calvary Redevelopment Committee:

Thank God that our project is still on schedule. We are now in the final stage of the construction and installation works.

101, Yuan Ching Road (Temporary Holding Site)

We took over this Temporary Site from SLA on 1 October 2014, and time flid, we have been here for

almost two years. Thank God that there were no major incidents after the water pipe burst incident in August 2015.

The co-sharing of the place between CBPC and JCC were satisfactory for the last two years, and our plan to move back to 1 Tao Ching Road by November 2016, and to return our portion of this site to SLA by year end is still on track.

1 Tao Ching Road Progress Status:

The construction and system installation works as at 15th August 2016 progressed smoothly. The Substation was handed over to SP Services on 28th June 2016, and power turned on by 11th July 2016. Incoming pipe for water has been connected, and water supply was turned on by 28th July 2016. We are now at the final phase of the construction and system integration and installations, and it is a challenging task to coordinate to ensure all are done according to our requirements. The aircon system and lifts were installed and tested. The Fire Safety and Mechanical

Ventilation Systems have also been installed, and waiting for the Registered Inspector's Inspection (RI) which is scheduled for end of August 2016, so that we can obtain Temporary Occupation Permit (TOP) by September 2016.

Construction Progress as of 15th August 2016

The Church Session Members, JCK Staff and Fellowship Group Leaders had walked the site in June and July 2016, and room allocations done for all user groups. Furnishes of the rooms and sanctuary will be done in September and October 2016. Moving-in plan being finalized and the proposed schedule is as follows:

1. Packing: from 15th September to 5th November 2016.
2. Moving in:

3. JCK Interactive Boards installation on 8th and 9th November 2016;
4. JCK Furniture and equipment from 8th to 9th November 2016;
5. Church Furniture and equipment from 10th to 16th November 2016.

Covert prayers for wisdom and unity of all to continue with the moving back planning; to coordinate and supervise all the remaining activities by the Redevelopment Project Committee, Consultants, Main Con and Sub-Contractors for the project to continue safely and smoothly, so that the construction could be completed on schedule.


